Professorship in Social and Cultural Anthropology (open rank)

available from August 1, 2019.

The department of Social and Cultural Anthropology invites applications from candidates with expertise in the field of medical anthropology. We expect applicants to have international visibility, fieldwork experience and substantial publications on empirical subjects that complement the existing specialities at the Department. Teaching responsibilities include courses at the BA-and MA-level in socio-cultural Anthropology, as well as contributions to the cross-disciplinary programs “Cultural Studies” and “World Society and Global Governance”.

The position will be filled at either the full (tenured) level, or at the assistant (tenure-track) level: the full professorship requires completion of the Habilitation (or equivalent achievements); the assistant professorship requires a PhD and engagement in current research that might lead to the Habilitation.

The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences considers itself a cooperative association of disciplines from the humanities and the social sciences. Aside from the general disciplinary requirements, the successful candidate should therefore also be versed in interdisciplinary research and teaching. All candidates are also expected to have a strong commitment to team-work and be willing to contribute to the development of the Faculty. A working knowledge of German is required.

In the interest of gender diversity in research and teaching, the University strongly encourages applications from women. Candidates should send their application with the usual documents (including a recent journal publication) in electronic form to kssf@unilu.ch.
